Dear Jean:

As a result of the recent strike action by your Association, a number of ten month employees have made inquiries regarding their entitlement to Employment Insurance (EI) benefits and access to a Record of Employment required for any application to be made by the employee.

The Calgary Board of Education cannot make any definitive statements about qualifying for EI as each applicant is considered on an individual basis by the Government of Canada. However, I would like to make you aware that Superintendents' Team has carefully explored the issue of Record of Employment requirements for the ten month employees. The Team continues to be unconditionally constructive in its attempts to deal with Staff Association during this strike and for that reason have decided to issue Record of Employment documents at the end of June to enable ten month employees to file for Employment Insurance. We trust this is yet one more indicator of our efforts to reach a settlement with Staff Association and we hope that Staff Association will communicate this to their membership accordingly.

Please be aware that the Calgary Board of Education will be communicating its intent to issue Records of Employment to affected staff this week. This approach is consistent with our practice of prior years.
