Do I have to picket my school?

No. There will not be pickets set up at all worksites. A schedule of picket sites will be organized over the next few days.

Is there strike pay?

There may be an amount paid for each picket shift you attend. The details are still in the works as it will depend on how long strike action continues. If you choose not to attend picket shifts, you will not qualify for picket pay.

I have a doctor's appointment on Wednesday morning. Do I have to let someone know I won't be picketing then?

No. Members will sign in at picket sites, but are not required to let anyone know if they will not be there.

My principal asked me for my passwords. Should I be sharing this information?

NO! When you had a system account set up, you signed an agreement where you agreed to keep your password confidential. You are not permitted to give your password to anyone.

I was asked to set up a list of instructions for my tasks so someone else can do the while I am out on strike. What should I do?

You are not required to train others to do your job.

I had holidays already booked for these days. Do I lose my holidays?

Take your holidays as planned. If you are deducted for these days, then you are still entitled to those holiday days. This is only for days already requested. You are not able to book holidays on known strike days.

I am on sick leave. How does this strike action affect my leave?

It's possible that the CBE will stop payment for those days where strike action is occurring. If you are on long-term disability, you should not be affected. If you are on WCB, the WCB payments should not be affected.
