

RESULTS OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, APRIL 24, 2006

We have submitted an application to hold a strike vote on May 3, 2006. This vote will ask members whether they are in favor of strike action. It is most important that ALL Staff Association members vote on this action.

The ballot will read: “Are you in favour of taking strike action?”

Voting to support strike action DOES NOT mean we are walking out at this point – there are many ways to strike against one’s employer.

It was decided at Monday’s meeting that strike action will include the following:

- Working to rule
- No overtime
- No extra time
- No “on call”
- Radio commercials to be broadcast outlining our position
- Media coverage to be broadcast outlining our position
- Support from other Unions (including ATA and CUPE)
- Information pickets at various worksites

The voting will take place on Wednesday, May 3, 2006 at the Glenmore Inn in the Ogden Room. Polls will be open from 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. on that day.

This is a government supervised vote and will take place under the Labour Board’s regulations and procedures. Voting will take place via secret ballot.
